PARENT CONNECTION

WHEN GOD CALLS, WE WILL OBEY – EXODUS 3-4

Reread today's story from Exodus 3-4 as a family.

God calls Moses and Moses gives various excuses. We know that if God calls us to it, he will be with us through it. God told Moses that he wanted him to lead His people out of slavery in Egypt and to the Promised Land. God can talk to us anywhere and when God calls, we will obey just like Moses did.

Over a meal, car ride, or free time, ask your kids what this story about Moses obeying taught them.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

What is something new you learned today? What stood out in the message?

What does Exodus mean? (departure) What does that tell us about the Book of Exodus?

Did God speak to Moses before or after he got a closer look at the burning bush (Exodus 3:4 - after)? What do you think would have happened if Moses hadn't noticed the burning bush or hadn't been curious about it? What signs do God put in your life that if you are curious might lead to God speaking further in your life? Be looking this week!
