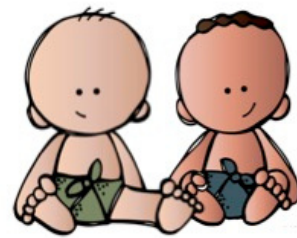
PARENT CONNECTION

DECEIVING IS WRONG – GENESIS 27

Reread today's story from Genesis 27 as a family.

Jacob deceived Isaac to get Esau's blessing. Jacob also had a bad influence who convinced him to do it.

Ask your kids if there are friends that they have that they think are a bad influence in their lives. Talk to them about what they should do if someone is trying to get them to do something they know is wrong.

2. **How would it feel to be Esau, knowing that you would not receive the family inheritance even though you were the firstborn?**
